Application for Exemption from Fees for Mandatory Solid Waste Collection Service

Section 8.16.070 A. of the Lakeport Municipal Code allows for owners or occupants not to be required to contract for solid waste collection service where such owner or occupant accumulates no garbage or rubbish, or who has an agreement with the City whereby the garbage or rubbish is being collected at least as often as the municipal collection and who complies with all health code requirements. In order to receive such an exemption, the owner or occupant is required to file with the City Manager or designee an application stating the reasons for exemption from the payment of such fees. This section further requires the City Manager or his designee to make such investigations as deemed necessary to determine if the applicant should be granted such exemption.
