Even if the State supplements the cost (SHARE tag fees normally don't cover overhead expenses) the City at best will break even. A much better solution would be to contract with a licensed, professional guide. The guide would pay the City a negotiated amount for the season or by the animal, and would be required to accompany every hunter. This way the City actually makes money by eradicating feral hogs, the public gets the hunting opportunity, and the entire situation is much safer for the hunter, the public, and the neighbors.
