



## **NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE LAKEPORT CITY COUNCIL** will consider Executive Order 2020-01 at their next regular meeting on **Tuesday, April 7, 2020**, at 6:00 p.m. via teleconference. Meeting agenda and log-in instructions will be distributed to the press and public at least 72 hours prior to the meeting to allow public participation.

Executive Order 2020-01 has been issued by the City of Lakeport Director of Emergency Services. This order states that all orders issued by the Lake County Health Officer and the Governor of the State of California related to COVID-19 are enforceable under city ordinance. This executive order will be reviewed for ratification by the City of Lakeport City Council at their meeting to be held on April 7, 2020.
