

## CITY OF LAKEPORT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Lakeport will conduct a Public Hearing on July 20, 2021 at 6:00 pm in the City Council Chambers located 225 Park Street, Lakeport, CA.

The purpose of this hearing is to review and approve the accomplishments that were produced from the City of Lakeport's 14-CDBG-9883 CDBG Agreement, as amended, with the State of California and to solicit citizen input regarding the outcome and accomplishments of the funding received under this contract. The city was awarded \$400,000 and under an amendment, expended Program Income to carry out the following activities: General Administration, Economic Development Program, Planning Grant, and install ADA improvements to the Carnegie Library. All funds have been expended in accordance with the grant agreement.

Citizens will be given the opportunity to make their comments known and questions answered related to the grant listed above.
