TRAFFIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE AGENDA
REGULAR MEETING
Monday, March 11, 2019

- 1. CALL TO ORDER** Chair Dollosso called the meeting to order at 4:02 p.m. with Committee members Barrett, Brown, Cole and Maxman present.
- 2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES** A motion was made by Committee member Brown, seconded by Committee member Cole, and unanimously carried by voice vote, to approve the Minutes of the January 14, 2019 meeting.
- 3. PUBLIC INPUT** No comment was offered from the public.
- 4. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS**

 - A. Two Hour Parking Zone Request for area in front of 1050 North Main Street** A staff report was presented by Community Development Director Ingram.

Sandra Aguayo, owner of Lakeport Bait and Tackle spoke in favor of the two hour parking zone, stating that hotel customers and restaurant employees park in that area all day which restricts the parking for her patrons.

Donna Nozzolillo, owner of Nozzolillo’s Parlor, spoke in favor of the two hour parking zone and asked about ADA parking.

A motion was made by Committee member Maxman, seconded by Committee member Cole, and unanimously carried by voice vote to recommend the Lakeport City Council consider amending Resolution 2431 (2011) providing for designated 2-hour restricted parking for an approximately 75 foot area fronting three businesses at 1050 North Main Street.
 - B. Martin & Bevins Street Intersection Safety Concerns** Community Development Director Ingram gave a staff report.

After review and discussion of traffic safety related concerns at the intersection of Martin and Bevins Streets, the TSAC asked staff to refer the item back to Public Works Staff and the City Engineer for further review and recommendations back to TSAC.
 - C. Brown Act Overview** City Clerk Buendia gave an overview on the Ralph M. Brown Act as it relates to the Traffic Safety Advisory Committee.
- 5. GENERAL TRAFFIC ITEMS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS** Committee member Brown asked Lt. Ferguson for an update on flooding.
